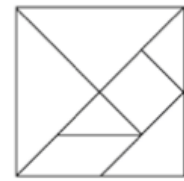


# Vocabulary for First Grade Module 5: Identifying, Composing, and Partitioning Shapes

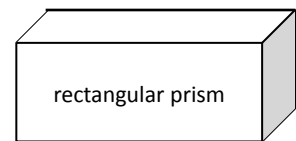
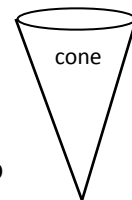
- ▶ Attributes (characteristics of an object such as color or number of sides)
- ▶ Composite shapes (shapes composed of two or more shapes)
- ▶ Digital clock
- ▶ Fourth of (shapes), fourths (1 out of 4 equal parts)
- ▶ Half-hour (interval of time lasting 30 minutes)
- ▶ Half of, halves (1 out of 2 equal parts)
- ▶ Half past (expression for 30 minutes past a given hour)
- ▶ Hour hand (component on clock tracking hours)
- ▶ Minute hand (component on clock tracking minutes)
- ▶ O'clock (used to indicate time to a precise hour, with no additional minutes)
- ▶ Quarter of (shapes) (1 out of 4 equal parts)
- ▶ Tangram (a puzzle made of seven flat shapes, called tans, which are put together to form larger shapes)
- ▶ Three-dimensional shapes:
  - ▶ Cone
  - ▶ Rectangular prism
- ▶ Two-dimensional shapes:
  - ▶ Half-circle
  - ▶ Quarter-circle
  - ▶ Rhombus (flat figure with four straight sides of the same length and which has two pairs of opposite sides that are parallel)
  - ▶ Trapezoid (a figure with four straight sides in which at least one pair of opposite sides is parallel)

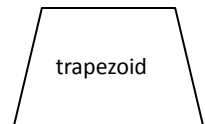
half-circle
